Officers will pay particular attention to aggressive drivers, speeders, and those violating seatbelt and child restraint laws. This saturation patrol is being conducted as part of our commitment to safe travel on our highways and is funded by a Wide Area Saturation Patrol (WASP) grant from the Governor's Highway Safety Office.
