Regardless of the mode, the Bidder shall be responsible for the early delivery of their bid. Mailed or hand-delivered bids should be in a sealed envelope and labeled "Ready-Mix Concrete, RFB 25082, Bid Enclosed". The subject line of e-mailed bids shall state the same. Bids received after the deadline will be unopened and discarded.

Proposal Evaluation

In addition to the bid amount, additional factors will be considered as an integral part of the bid evaluation process, including, but not limited to:

- A. The Vendor's experience, reputation, efficiency, judgment, and integrity.
- B. The quality, availability and adaptability of the requested products or services.
- C. The Vendor's ability to provide future maintenance and/or services.
- D. Any other applicable factors as the City determines necessary and appropriate (which may be requested by the city prior to award).

Award of Contract

The City holds the right, in its judgment, to award the contract to the vendor(s) which it feels is in the best interest of the City. If a contract is to be awarded, the Contractor/Vendor selection shall be based in whole or in part on the evaluation noted above. No submittal shall be withdrawn for a period of sixty (60) days subsequent to the opening of bids without the consent of the City of Alcoa.

Laws, Permits and Regulations

The Contractor shall comply with all State and Local laws, ordinances, regulations and requirements applicable to work hereunder. If the Contractor ascertains at any time that any requirement of this Contract is at variance with applicable laws, ordinances, regulations, or other requirements, she/he shall promptly notify the City of Alcoa in writing.

Cancellation of Award

The City reserves the right to cancel the award of any contract at any time before the execution of such contract by all parties without any liability against the City. The Vendor is advised that if in the event appropriated funds are legitimately unavailable for this product in successive fiscal years, such purchase orders resulting from this bid are null and void.

Cooperative Purchasing

Unless stated otherwise, vendor agrees that it shall be permissible for other governments in Tennessee to purchase these items or services at the same price. Freight charges can be adjusted to reflect differences in delivery costs.

Iran Divestment Act

By submission of this bid, each bidder and each person signing on behalf of any bidder certifies, and in the case of a joint bid each party thereto certifies as to its own organization, under penalty of perjury, that to the best of its knowledge and belief that each bidder is not on the list created pursuant to § 12-12-106.

READY-MIX CONCRETE

SCOPE OF WORK

The City of Alcoa Public Works Department is requesting written quotations for the furnishing of Ready-Mix Concrete during the period of July 1, 2025 through June 30, 2026. Prices bid shall include all materials, labor, equipment, and transportation costs necessary for delivery of the concrete to sites within the service areas of the City of Alcoa. **Product ordered by 9:00 a.m. must be made available to the City by 9:00 a.m. the following business day.** Contacts for purchases under this contract are the division supervisors of the Alcoa Public Works Department.

CONCRETE CLASSIFICATIONS

- A. Class "A" Concrete (Structures): Unless otherwise specified, all concrete shall be Class A.
 - 1. Fine Aggregate: proportioned by dry weight of fine to coarse aggregates between 30-45%.
 - 2. Coarse Aggregates: Size No. 57 - Structural Concrete.
 - 3. Minimum Compressive Strength: 28 day, 4000 psi.
 - 4. Slump: 1 to 3 inches for mass concrete and heavy reinforcement section; 2 to 4 inches for slabs, columns, girders, walls, etc.

- B. Class "P" Concrete (Base and Pavement)
 - 1. Fine Aggregate: do not use sand manufactured from limestone for traffic lane pavements.
 - 2. Coarse Aggregate: Size No. 57.
 - 3. Minimum Compressive Strength: 14 day, 3500 psi.
 - 4. Slump: 2 to 1-1/2 inches, workable consistency.

- C. Class "B" Concrete: Use for anchors, kickers, encasement for pipelines, sub-foundations, mass footings, and fill (unless otherwise specified).
 - 1. Fine Aggregate: proportion by dry weight of fine to coarse aggregates between 30 - 45%. Test for potential alkali reactivity (if requested) per ASTM C-289-71. Use natural river sand or specially approved manufactured sand.
 - 2. Coarse Aggregate: Size No. 57 or 67 as specified.
 - 3. Minimum Cement Content: 5.0 bags (470 lbs.) per cubic yard.
 - 4. Minimum Compressive Strength: 28 day, 3000 psi.
 - 5. Slump: 5 to 8 inches for pipe encasements; 2 to 4 inches in sub-foundations and other specified areas.

- D. Flowable Fill and Pervious Concrete
 - 1. Per TDOT specifications, or
 - 2. Contractor to submit mix design for review and approval.

INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS

E. The Contractor shall assume all liability for operations relative to this contract. Minimum insurance coverage of \$1,000,000 General Liability and \$1,000,000 Automobile Accident Liability shall be acquired and maintained by the Contractor. Certificates of Insurance shall be submitted.

F. The successful Bidder agrees to execute a contract for providing ready-mix concrete to the City of Alcoa in accordance with the foregoing conditions and specifications. Unit prices bid shall include all necessary costs for mobilization, insurance, etc. As stated, the duration of this contract will be from JULY 1, 2025 through JUNE 30, 2026.
